


Jesus chooses his disciples.

Listen to my teachings, my friends. Be kind to one another. Forgive each other.






Adam, Eve, Cain and Abel are thankful
to God for His creation.














Zacchaeus is a tax collector in Jericho.

His clothes are very expensive.






Zacchaeus is very short. People are taller than Zacchaeus. He cannot see Jesus.

down his net and Peter always catches the fish.




The nets

Jesus calls James and John.




Jonah is a good man. He loves God, but this time he is disobedient to God's word.

I don't want to go there. There are evil and bad people. They don't deserve your love.


Jonah is disobedient...
